Submission for presentations for the *2009 Aging with Passion and Purpose Conference* that will be held at the University of Nebraska at Omaha are now being accepted. This year's conference theme is "Social and Spiritual Dimensions of Aging and Caregiving." To submit a presentation proposal, please send an email to champs@crossandheart.org that includes the following information:

- Presentation title
- 300 word abstract describing the content of your presentation and how it relates to the conference theme of social and spiritual dimensions of aging and caregiving
- 3 learning objectives for your proposed session
- Type* of presentation you are interested in:

- 1) Paper**—single paper session, 20 to 60 minutes in length
- 2) Poster—wall poster to be displayed all day each day of conference with a designated time (up to 60 minutes) for author(s) to be near poster to answer questions
- 3) Symposium**—multiple paper session, up to 3 presenters, 20 minute length for each presenter
- 4) Interactive Workshop—60 minute session, single presenter/facilitator, involving practical, "hands-on" learning opportunities for participants

** **Please note** that preferences for type of presentation will be accommodated as much as possible, however, an alternative form of presentation may be requested from the conference planning committee if necessary.*

*** The conference planning committee reserves the right to group together papers/presenters focused on similar topics.*

- Name, title/credentials, affiliation, contact information, and a 100 word biography of the primary presenter(s)
- Audio-visual needs
- Special requests

The method of selection used for submissions will be a peer review process. The target date to notify applicants of acceptance or regrets is July 10, 2009. Upon acceptance, presenters will be requested to complete required documentation for CEU offerings.
